#### **Classroom Activities for Introverted Students**

- Assign independent assignments/projects.
- ❖ Set up individual conferences. Extroverted students may find it easy to raise their hand and ask a question, but introverted students will often be too shy or scared to do so.
- ❖ Create a group project that requires smaller groups.
- ❖ Give introverts the time to process information and respond later.
- Brainstorming techniques
  - ❖ Do ask introverts for their input (don't forget the quiet ones).
  - Encourage introverts to do some personal brainstorming <u>before</u> they come to the group session.
  - ❖ At the end of the group session, summarize the findings. Introverts can use this as a launch point to generate further ideas after the session. Extroverts can too, of course!

#### **Extrovert Characteristics**

Extroversion is a preference to <u>focus on the world outside the self</u>. Extroverts <u>enjoy social</u> <u>interactions and tend to be enthusiastic, verbal, assertive, and animated</u>. They <u>enjoy large social gatherings</u>, such as parties and any kind of group activity. Extroverts are likely to enjoy time spent with people and find themselves energized by social interaction.

### **Introvert Characteristics**

Introversion is a preference to <u>focus on the world inside the self</u>. Introverts <u>tend to be quiet</u>, <u>peaceful and deliberate and are not attracted to social interactions</u>. They prefer <u>activities they can do alone or with one other close friend</u>, <u>activities such as reading</u>, <u>writing</u>, <u>thinking</u>, <u>and inventing</u>. Introverts find social gatherings draining.
